The Student will:

- Create works of art in a variety of styles and media including: charcoal, pen and ink, printmaking (styrofoam engraving), clay sculpting (slab construction) and plaster cloth.
- Understand and apply the basic principles of design: balance, contrast, emphasis, proportion, pattern, rhythm and unity.
- Understand and use visual art vocabulary: analogous colors, warm and cool colors, focal point, perspective, armature, impressionism, and surrealism.
- Be able to recognize the style of work of well known artists such as Monet, Van Gogh, Dali, Seurat, Renior, Cassat, Michaelangelo, Raphael, and Matisse.
- Compare and contrast works of art.
