### **WHAT EVERY STUDENT SHOULD KNOW BY THE END OF FIFTH GRADE – INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC**

#### **THE STUDENT WILL BE ABLE TO:**

- Do a performance of Concert B flat scale on instrument.
- Recognize and do a performance of simple music notation and musical terms.
- Properly assemble and maintain a musical instrument.
- Count and clap rhythms consisting of whole notes, half notes, quarter notes, eighth notes, dotted half notes, dotted quarter notes, dotted eighth notes, sixteenth notes, and all corresponding rests.
- Show recognition and performance of note names within practical playing ranges of instrument.
- Show recognition and adjustment of tuning on instrument.
- Do a performance of simple one-part song for winter recital and performance of 5<sup>th</sup> grade band music for spring concert.
- Do simple meter recognition and performance in the following time signatures: 4/4, 2/4, 3/4, and common time.
- Show recognition and ability to follow conducting patterns in above meters and musical phrasing.
